A training evening will be run at the club’s premises on 15th May at 1900hours at Tighphuirt on the A82 which will be open to both club members and any other interested persons. The training session will be presented by Laura and Paul Macadam – Slater of Emergency Action Training in Fort William. Laura and Paul are well versed in defibrillator techniques.

Club Treasurer Alec Blanc added “we are indeed fortunate that Laura and Paul are prepared to give their time to ensure that everyone is familiar with the equipment. The defibrillator will be located outside the clubhouse in a secure and alarmed cabinet and thus available to all.”
